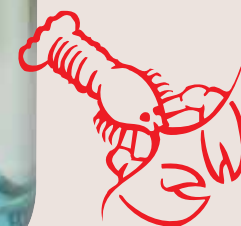

Wolf Blass Gold Label Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon

Twenty dollars for a high quality Barossa Shiraz or Coonawarra Cabernet is not a lot to pay. The question of value and how to tell 'what is value' in a bottle of wine arises all the time. No one wants to pay more than the wine is worth. With that said, what seems simple, which is answering that question, is far from easy. If we look at these wines, we find a premium region; a company with access to vast vineyard resources so they can select the best; a team of great winemakers; and the clincher, a winery that is set up to make wine in a way that duplicates what small boutique wineries do. Toss in the fact that our tasting samples were excellent and we come to the conclusion the wine is great value. We might go further and say the wine is undervalued on a world scale.

Not really, the important point is the remarkable Sue Hodder, with Allen Jenkins, have produced a ripping Coonawarra. They used new oak barrels, old barrels and a portion of unoaked fruit to keep it fresh and fruity, the colour dark purple, the nose ripe cherry, lavender and spice, flavours classic Cabernet fruitiness, malleable tannins and balanced with fresh acid.

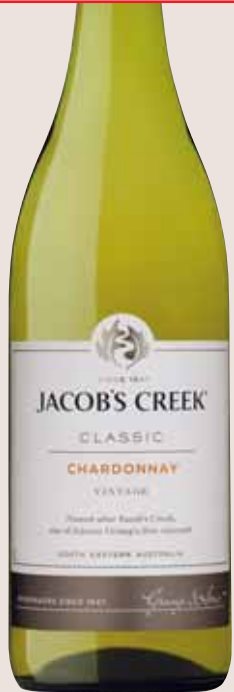
Houghton Classic Red Cabernet Shiraz Merlot

To achieve this consistent quality every year he or she is allowed to blend in other years, because it is a NV or not specific Vintage. In this case we believe wine was used from three different years. Trilogy is "a wine for all seasons" in that it is just right for celebrations, anytime easy drinking or at a dinner party. It will match with almost all entrees, salads or even a cheese platter.

Jacob's Creek Chardonnay Pinot Noir NV

We have been a big supporter of this wine since its first release in the late 1990's. Back then it busted the market apart as it offered very high quality for a modest amount. In our view it still does. Most wine judges have the view that the best sparkling wines are made from the grape varieties traditionally grown in the Champagne region of France. These are of course Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, the two varieties used to make this budget wine. You may of course make sparkling wine from any grape variety you like, though the results from using these two varieties are pleasing; so many winemakers globally are content to stick with the trusted duo. It took a long time to grow stocks of these varieties so it is only recently that they have found their way down to the budget end.

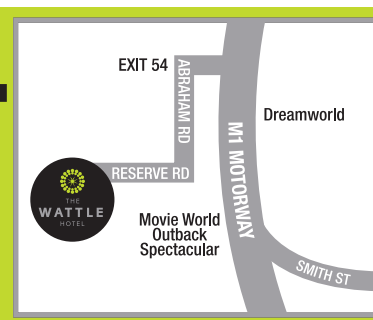
