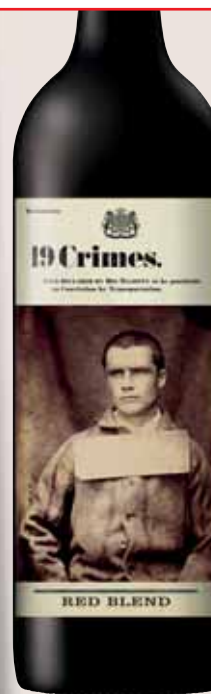

Wolf Blass Yellow Label Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz

Yes, Wolf Blass was brought out from Germany as an expert on sparkling wines, but fairly soon he was out on his own, launching his style on red and white table wines, and even though he sold the Winery many years ago, that style was so strong that it shines through still. In essence the wines must show the taste of the grape variety but not necessarily be fruity sweet. The flavours should not be big and bold rather they should be smooth and delightful, ready to drink right now, but leaving room for cellaring improvement as well. And of course the oak, Wolfie wanted it subtle and uplifting, not bashing you under the tasting table with a lump of 6 x 4. Here is a chance at a very reasonable price to touch his history and of course if a special occasion arises grab a more expensive Blass - it will make the day.

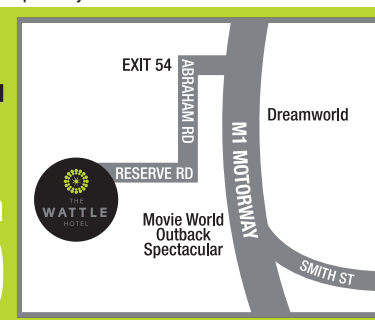
